Our Mission

St. Charles Borromeo Philippine Medical Mission (SCBPMM) is dedicated to promoting the inherent right of the poor in the Philippines to receive basic and adequate health care and to empower them, through education, to become responsible and productive members of society. Founded in 1999, SCBPMM incorporated with 501(c) tax exempt status in 2005.

What We Do

Provide care to the poor and abandoned elderly, orphans and physically and mentally handicapped persons. Working with ANAWIM Lay Missions, which is dedicated to giving comfort and dignity to the abandoned elderly during the waning years of their lives.

Provide basic health and nutrition services, and microfinance to indigenous industries and small businesses for family self-

sufficiency. Working with *The Archbishop Gabriel M. Reyes Memorial Foundation, Inc. (AGMRMFI)*, founded to undertake programs for poor senior citizens and school children with disabilities.

Provide health care services through a mobile health clinic, livelihood training, and counseling support to street children. Working with Childhope

Philippines (CHAP) to address the plight of street children in Metro Manila.

Support community development and basic health care services for the indigenous tribes in Mindanao. Working with *The Religious of Notre Dame of the*

Missions (RNDM) serving the Philippines since 1987.

Support medical missions, feeding centers, and livelihood projects. Working with The Foundation of Our Lady of Peace Mission, Inc. (FOLPMI) serving the poorest of the poor.

Provide shelter, meals, and education for the scavenger children in the slum areas and dump sites in Tondo,

Manila. Working with *Tulay ng Kabataan (TNK)* founded in 1998 to help street children and those living in the slum.
